

MATERIAL CHANGES TO MODEL UoSA

Clause	Description	Details of Change
2.1(i)	Distributor's services and obligations	Point of Connection deleted and Point of Supply substituted, more correctly reflecting the point, defined in the electricity Act 1992, at which statutory voltage limits are measured. Also amended to provide that measurement equipment will be installed as near as practicable to the Point of Supply.
12.1	Retailer will satisfy prudential requirements	In accordance with the relevant MUoSA practice note, this clause has been redrafted to make it clear that a retailer will be expected to satisfy prudential requirements from the commencement date.
12.24(g)	Trust account rules	Modified to allow that the Distributor need only provide the retailer with an annual report in respect of the operation of the Trust Account "to the extent that such reports are available from the banking provider".
21.1	Termination	Modified to allow the party receiving notice (at will) of termination to give notice that it wishes to enter into a new agreement, and for the parties to negotiate, in good faith, with a view to concluding a new agreement.
31.2	Definitions	"Consumer Service Lines" definition amended to delete Point of Connection and substitute Point of Supply, more correctly reflecting the point at which consumers' responsibilities for service lines commences.
31.2	Definitions	"Disclosure Requirements" definition amended to reflect amendments made under the Commerce Amendment Act 2008 and new information disclosure requirements determined by the Commerce Commission.
31.2	Definitions	"Dispute Resolution Scheme" definition amended to correctly state the title of the Electricity and Gas Complaints Commissioner scheme.
31.2	Definitions	"Electrical Installation" definition amended to delete Point of Connection substitute Point of Supply, more correctly reflecting the point demarcation for works and installations.
31.2	Definitions	"Point of Supply" added to definitions, and has the meaning attributed to it in the Electricity Act 1992.
31.2	Definitions	"Publish" definition amended to provide that published information will be sent to the Retailer electronically, rather than in hard copy.
