2. Excavation work near any pole, staywire, or ground mounted fixture must not exceed the depths listed in the following table, unless stated otherwise in Condition 7 (below):

Distance:	Within 2.2m	2.2m to 5.0m	No mechanical excavation is permitted within 2m of a 66kV, 33kV or fibre optic cable
Max Depth:	300mm	750mm	

3. Where any mobile plant is likely to be used at any time in the proximity of overhead lines, the owner or operator of such device shall affix an approved warning notice in a conspicuous place as near as practicable to the operator's position. The notice shall be maintained in a legible condition and shall state: **"WARNING, KEEP CLEAR OF POWER LINES"**
4. The Site Supervisor shall report to System Control daily (Dunedin (03) 479-6664, Central Otago (03) 445-3438), and provide an estimated daily completion time.
5. A copy of this approval must be held on site at all times, and available for viewing by all staff.
